After hearing, the officials representing the Institute, the Review Application is partly allowed to the extent of Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) run by the said Institute. The fees earlier approved as Rs. 77,000/- for the Academic Year 2021-2022 is revised as Rs. 79,000/-.

After hearing, the officials requested to allow the Institute to withdraw the Review filed by the Institute to the extent of Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) as they were satisfied with the assessment of fees made for the said course for the Academic Year 2021-2022.

The withdrawal application filed by the Institute is taken on record. The Review Application is disposed of as withdrawn.

Review Application No. PH-22/05 filed by the Vidya Niketan College of Pharmacy, Pune (PH6943).

"Discussed

The Institution has filed review applications seeking review of fees determined for Diploma in Pharmacy and Bachelor of Pharmacy courses run by the Institute for the academic year 2021-2022.

The Review Application has been filed without payment of the requisite process fee. As against the process fee of Rs. 15,000/- to be payable, the Institute has paid Rs. 5,000/- only. The deficiency in respect of payment of process fee has not been removed till date.

The Principal of the Institute has sent a letter dated 21/04/2022 informing that the Institute is satisfied with the fees determined by the Fees Regulating Authority and requested to allow the Institute to withdraw the application.

The Review Application is disposed of as dismissed for want of payment of requisite process fee as well as for want of prosecution."

There is a delay of 98 days in filing the review application.

In brief, it is the contention of the Vice-Principal of The institute that the delay was not deliberate. It is submitted that the Institute has submitted the Review Application within time through the online process. However, the Institute was unaware of the process of payment of the process fee to be paid along with the review application. Due to non-payment of the processing fee, the review application could not be uploaded within the stipulated period. After ascertaining the process of payment of the process fee the Institute has paid the requisite process fee on 15/06/2021. Due to this reason, the delay caused in filling the Review Application has been condoned.
