The Memorandum of Understanding between the Prevest Denpro limited. Export promotion Industrial Park, Baribrahmana, Jammu, J&K and RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar, is being signed on 14.07.2020

The MOU is being signed on the prospect that both the Parties collaborate on developing the joint academic and research co-operation between the two institutes.

For Collaborative Research and academic activities

The scope of MoU is to define a mechanism to promote interdisciplinary research; impart skill oriented training and other programs to benefit student and staff of both organizations; joint research and academic activities leading to academic excellence; new knowledge generation; innovative technology development; professional skill and competence development; vocational training capacity building and many such synergies of interdisciplinary research through collaboration and networking of RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and Prevest Denpro limited, Jammu

1. OBJECTIVES

RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and Prevest Denpro limited will undertake joint research work in the areas of mutual interest:

- To form a nucleus for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of Dental science and allied sciences with special emphasis on Biomaterials ,Drugs, herbals, Regenerative science and related fields etc.
- The concerned scientists of Prevest Denpro limited and corresponding faculty members of RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar together will formulate joint research projects, syllabi for joint academic programs, new courses, and training for skill oriented Human Resources with due approval of both the institute and within the framework of rules and regulation governing both the organizations.
- Training programs on state of art topics of interdisciplinary research for faculty, staff, student and technical personnel of both the organizations within the area of co-operation will be undertaken at both the institutes.

o To work on collaborative research projects involving other agencies of the region and work towards development of concerned regions keeping in view the interests and philosophies of each other.

2. SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTION

- ✓ Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- ✓ Practical training of testing protocols for RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar students at Prevest Denpro Limited;
- ✓ Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in Biomaterials, Drugs, herbals, Regenerative science and related fields etc.and other areas of national interest at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar by Prevest Denpro Limited on mutually agreeable terms.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited would accommodate B.Pharm, M.Pharm, PhD and Fellowship students in such a number that Prevest Denpro Limited deems convenient to it for the purpose of Research, imparting Training and others.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited may depute its personnel as visiting faculty At RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar to teach any of the regular Course or specialized topics.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited personnel, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their Ph.D at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar. Further, Prevest Denpro Limited may request to design and teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited may seek assistance/guidance of RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited will seek assistance/guidance of RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar faculty member/s in clinical evaluation, clinical trials, post market surveillance, post market feedback and biocompatibility

- ✓ Would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instrument, etc.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited may showcase its business activities at the seminar/workshop/conference, etc. at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar.
- ✓ Prevest Denpro Limited may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar
- ✓ A Research Scientist at Prevest Denpro Limited may be appointed a Co-research guide as per the rules of the respective institute for a student Registered for Ph.D degree at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar. The student maybe encouraged to take up the project such that Prevest Denpro Limited desirably benefits from its outcomes.
- ✓ RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and Prevest Denpro Limited would make joint proposals for funding from agencies such as DBT, DBT, CSIR, ICMR, DST, etc
- ✓ The students can carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or M.D.S/B.D.S project at RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and Prevest Denpro Limited depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements.
- ✓ There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- ✓ Both RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and Prevest Denpro Limited will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this scheme.
- ✓ If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc by the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- ✓ Research supervisors from both the Institutes will be the corresponding authors in any publication resulting from the collaborative work. All the efforts put by the student/s as

a part of this MoU will be accounted for by way of reporting the work in thesis and/or paper publication except the part for which IPR needs be claimed.

- ✓ Neither of the supervisors will publish the work carried out under this MoU without knowledge of the other.
- ✓ In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

3. EXCHANGE/DEPUTATION OF STAFF

- To exchange faculty/technical personnel on full-time/part time basis for a limited period not exceeding one year at a time for the purpose of implementation of joint tasks within the areas of co-operation.
- That the faculty/staff and research fellows registered for Ph.D. degree may visit the other institution for a short period in connection with their research work under joint collaboration program.
- That the faculty/technical personnel will be encouraged to deliver lectures/invited talks in the other organization.

4. JOINT CONFERENCE/WORKSHOP/COURSES

Both the parties agree to hold/conduct, whenever feasible, national events, Joint workshops, conferences, training programs within the areas of mutual interest.

5. SHARING OF FACILITIES

- The two organizations agree to share their respective important R &D facilities in order to promote academic and research in the areas of cooperation to intensity the high priority area program of science and technology.
- * Both the organizations agree to share and utilize equipments, facilities, hardware, software and other materials & components developed in house in the area of co-operation if advisable within the framed rules governing both the organizations.

6. PROJECTS WORK OF STUDENTS

A total of 4-5 selected students of U.G., P.G. and research in the respective areas of specialization of University/ college will be allowed at a time for project work at Prevest Denpro Limited. Students will work in the areas of mutually agreeable areas identified by the both organizations.

7. AREAS OF MUTUAL INTEREST

The areas of co-operation will be defined and modified from time to time by the co-operation committee set up for the purpose. The areas identified for co-operation are Dental Biomaterials, Wound healing, Regenerative Sciences, Biotechnology, Biosciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Medicinal Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Physical Pharmacy, Toxic genomics, Pharmaceutical Engineering and Technology, herbals, food & Nutrition, etc.

This Agreement places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either Party. These activities will be defined through separate program agreements that detail the commitment of resources (financial or otherwise) required by each Institution. Subsequent program agreements must be approved in writing by the authorized representatives of each institution.

Dr. Sai Kalyan will serve as the primary liaison between the two institutions to facilitate the development of future activities.

Terms

This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by both Parties. It shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both Parties. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party with advance written notice of at least thirty (30) days. Upon notice of termination both RSM's N.N. Sattha College of Pharmacy, Ahmednagar and PREVEST DENPRO LTD agree to work in good faith to enable visiting scholars to complete their respective research programs unhindered by the termination. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two Parties after the five-year period, and it must be renewed in writing.

This Memorandum of Understanding completed in English is hereby signed in two (2) copies with one (1) copy remaining in the possession of each institution.
